

## **Local Rules 2023**



### **Markings**

White: Out of bounds

Red: Penalty area

Blue: Abnormal ground conditions

Red-Green: No play zone, do not enter

### **Distances to the Front of the Green**

Blue - 75 m, Red - 100 m, White - 125 m, Yellow - 150 m, Blue - 200 m

Green posts with white stripes: 135 m to middle of green

### **Local Rules**

Houses are integral parts of the course and are not immovable obstructions.

### **Immovable Obstructions, Rule 16.1**

Roads, benches, tee boards, bells, irrigation connections, sprinklers, fences, distance markers, directional poles, manhole covers, embedded stones in the terrain, drainages, drainage ditches beside roads, trees with support posts.

### **Dropping Zones**

Dropping zones have been set up at holes 11 and 14:

On hole 11, as an additional option to Rule 17.1, the player may drop the ball in the designated zone with a penalty stroke.

On hole 14, if the ball lies in the fen between the tee and the dropping zone, the ball must be dropped with a penalty stroke in the designated zone.

### **Entering and playing in the fen is prohibited!**

### **Interruption of Play: Rule 5.7a and Note**

Rule 5.7a explains the procedure to be followed when play is interrupted. In case of danger, play shall be stopped immediately after the announcement of the stoppage of play. If a player does not stop play immediately, he shall be disqualified.

A stoppage of play is signalled as follows:

- a) Sirens sound 25 seconds without pause = immediate interruption of play due to imminent danger.
- b) Sirens sound 2 times 6 seconds with one repetition = resumption of play
- c) Sirens sound 2 times 10 seconds = definite and immediate abandonment of the game.
